Frequently Asked Questions

1. How much is the registration fee? Is there a fee assessed for late registration? How much is the audit fee?

- ✓ The registration fee is \$59.00
- ✓ The fee for registering after the deadline is \$69.00 – a \$10.00 fee applied
- ✓ The audit fee is \$55.00 and should registration be filed after the deadline, it is \$65.00

4. What is the deadline to register for each Unit? If a late registration needs to be made, is there an additional cost?

- ✓ The deadline for the unit is 1 week before the training so that the training site and instructors know how to plan.
- ✓ If a registration is made after that date or if ladies walk in on the day of the training, the registration fee is \$69.00 – a \$10.00 late fee is applied. (*answered as well in question 1*)

5. What is the advantage of completing the Program and receiving the certificate compared to just auditing the courses?

The huge advantage to completing the program is that the extra work required such as book reading and assignments will greatly enhance the Program and help the student receive more out of the training. The proof of study is always in the practical application of what we are doing. In the future, the completion of this Program will be criteria for those who serve on the national A.W.M. Leadership Team.

6. Is W.L.S. for only women in leadership in their A.W.M. group?

It definitely is not. Although W.L.S. was created to train the leadership in Alliance Women Ministries, this training is available to ANY lady. The reasons that this is available to all women are:

- ✓ All women are in a ministry somewhere whether it's through A.W.M. at their church or other ministries, raising their family, school activities, Bible Studies, etc....every lady can benefit from W.L.S. for their life...wherever they serve.
- ✓ Many women are not sure where their gifts are and W.L.S. helps them see the whole picture of ministry, especially Alliance Women's Ministries.
- ✓ There may be some women who are thinking about getting involved on a leadership team, but feels uncomfortable and not equipped in her skills. W.L.S. helps relieve this fear and assists women to become competent as well as confident to serve.
- ✓ W.L.S. is a great avenue for networking with other A.W.M. women. Many times women feel as if they are on an island by themselves and by attending our trainings, they are encouraged with ideas and frustrations shared – working out possible solutions by talking with others that have similar experiences.
- ✓ Boundaries and priorities are just two of the issues taught and this is needed in all of our lives. Should a lady not be in any type of ministry at the moment and doesn't perceive herself being in leadership, these classes are still very beneficial in her life.

7. Where do I find the W.L.S. schedule, syllabuses, and other information?

- ✓ www.alliancewomen.org – to gain access to the W.L.S. website, please ALWAYS go through the national A.W.M. website.
- ✓ On the A.W.M. web homepage to the left, you will see W.L.S. – click on that and you will be taken directly to our website. All of the necessary information is there.

8. W.L.S. states that the student can receive 3 college credits. How does this work?

- ✓ The student must attend and complete all requirements of all 4 units, satisfactory to the instructors and W.L.S. Director.
- ✓ The 3 college credits are offered by Crown College only and in order for a graduate to use those, they must be a student at Crown – either attending or via computer classes.
- ✓ Upon completing the requirements, the W.L.S. Administrative Assistant will contact the student for updated information which will appear on their Certificate as well as other pre-approved uses for that information. If the student wishes to receive 3 college credits from Crown, a Transcript of Credits for W.L.S. to Crown will be sent in for them.
