

Hurricane Ian Aftermath

"It's His ministry, and He's keeping it going," says Director Treva Crump. She and her husband Ben oversaw moving everything onto tables before the ground-floor Stamp Room was flooded with over two feet of water when Ian hit Shell Point on Sept. 28th, 2022. The ministry shut down for 6 weeks. Volunteers moved materials and mail to the ministry's new location on the 4th floor of the old healthcare Pavilion and once again began filling dealers' orders. Despite their forced closure and relocation, 66 faithful volunteers produced \$35,000 in income for 2022.

This income supports publishing and distribution of Spanish language Sunday School curriculum. More than 50 lesson series have been published and are being used in 40 denominations in Spanish-speaking countries in Latin America, Spain, and the U.S.
